Subject: 60 Day Notice of Annual General Meeting

As per policy approved at the General Meeting in April 1999, Theatre Saskatchewan Inc. procedures will be as follows:

- 1. Theatre Saskatchewan Inc. will inform Voting Member Clubs of the Annual General Meeting and/or the General Meeting with sixty (60) days' notice. With this notice, we will ask for any changes and/or additions to policy, and any other items for discussion. These written changes and additions must be received by the office and mailed to the Voting Members within thirty (30) days of the upcoming AGM. The Annual General Meeting will be held in the Home Inn & Suites Swift Current, 1411 Battleford Trail East in Swift Current on Sunday, November 6th, 2022 from 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. At this time, all changes and additions will require a 50% + 1 vote in order to pass.
- 2. All changes and additions must be in the office by Wednesday, October 5th, 2022 at 4:00 p.m. Late submissions, without prior review, will require a 2/3 majority in order to be presented at the meeting.
- 3. Please provide the office with your group's events over the past year to be included in the thirty (30) Day Notice.
- 4. All CLUB membership dues for the 2022-2023 year have been waived. Please renew our free membership by Friday, Wednesday, October 5th, 2022 in order to vote at the Annual General Meeting.

AS PER TSI BYLAWS: XII Amendments to By-Laws

- 1. The Board of Directors may, by resolution, make, amend or repeal any by-law that regulates the activities of the Association.
- 2. Any such change is effective from the day of the resolution of the Board of Directors until confirmed or rejected at the next General Meeting.
- 3. If the Membership rejects such change, the change ceases to be effective.
