

Executive Director's Report

This past year was challenging as we attempted to get back to in-person programming while still dealing with COVID-19 numbers. Once again, we did a combination of in-person and online programming. TSI's programming consisted of workshops, TheatreFest and grant funding to our members.

Moose Jaw Community Players approached us about hosting weekly workshops to reach out to people to build their membership and awareness in their community. During the summer and fall, they ran workshops once a week in the evening to encourage socialization and knowledge in improv and acting. TSI found the facilitators and paid them for their facilitation. These workshops were fun and successful pilot projects and have led to a new programming opportunity that TSI will introduce in 2023.

In September, we held our first stand-alone Script Scramble in Stoughton. We had nine participants who learned about play production at the Legion Hall in Stoughton and performed for a sold-out crowd at The Happy Nun Café in Forget. It was a night of great food and entertainment.

We were looking forward to our annual dinner theatre fundraiser in Regina, but we had to cancel it due to low ticket sales. Odyssey Productions from Prince Albert would volunteer their time to come to Regina

and perform *A Very Die Hard Christmas* after they performed it in Prince Albert.

We offered Saskatchewan playwrights online opportunities to work with Gordon Portman over four months through Zoom on scripts.

Then in June, we had in-person readings with volunteers in Saskatoon and Regina.

This workshop was an exciting project, and we got to work with six playwrights from around the province.

I would like to thank the Board of Directors for their time and commitment this past year. Nathan Breitenbach resigned from the Board and I will miss him, his knowledge, and his sense of humour. I wish him all the best in the future and look forward to working with him again. We were fortunate that Pamela Uhrmann agreed to sit on the Board for the remainder of the term. Welcome Back, Pamela!

The work we have done and continue to do could not be done without the generous support from the Sask Lotteries Trust Fund for Sport, Culture and Recreation. We are also proud to be members of SaskCulture and are grateful for all their resources to better our organization.

REPORT OF THE NOMINATING COMMITTEE 2022 THEATRE SASKATCHEWAN INC. ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING (AGM) OCTOBER 7, 2022

Two Directors of the Theatre Saskatchewan Inc. Board: Mathew Derworiz and Crystal Milburn, were appointed to act as the Nominating Committee for the 2022 Annual General Meeting.

Following past practice, the Nominating Committee sought to determine the number of Director positions eligible for election, the length of their remaining terms and whether there were any new nominations per Bylaw VII 1. other than incumbents.
